## Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to safeguard children. She keeps up-to-date with current legislation and knows the procedures to follow to report any concerns.
- The childminder knows how to help children learn to manage their behaviour, develop their independence, take turns and respect others.
- The childminder understands the importance of forming relationships with the local schools to help prepare children for their next stage in learning.
- The childminder knows how to use self-evaluation to reflect on her practice and help her identify areas to improve.
- The childminder is aware of how to encourage children to learn about leading healthy lifestyles, such as by providing healthy snacks and regular opportunities for exercise.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
