## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider and staff understand their responsibility to keep children safe. They are knowledgeable about safeguarding policy and procedures, including how to react to any concerns about a child's welfare.
- The provider recognises the importance of partnership working with parents. She explained clear procedures for helping children to settle quickly and form strong bonds with the staff members, so that children feel safe and enjoy their experience.
- The provider understands how to support children's social skills. She recognises the need to help children learn how to take turns and be respectful to each other.
- The provider recognises the importance of self-evaluation and reflection to identify areas for development and help continually improve her service.
- The provider understands how to plan a variety of play activities and experiences that are appropriate for children's ages and which take account of their interests. She knows how to organise the resources so they are accessible to all children and encourage them to make independent choices in their play.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector spoke to the provider about her practices and procedures, and how she intends to provide children with activities that reflect their interests and learning needs.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises that will be used for children and discussed safety arrangements.
- The inspector looked at samples of documentation and records that the provider will use to support children's welfare and ongoing development.
- The inspector discussed with the provider her systems for self-evaluation.

Nipperbout Crèche registered at the Bournemouth International Centre in 2006 and re-registered in 2011 due to change in legal entity. It is a mobile crèche company providing onsite childcare facilities at a range of venues throughout the country. The crèche is open on pre-arranged days as required. The manager holds Early Years Professional Status and the remaining three members of staff are all qualified in childcare or teaching. There were no early years children on roll at the time of this inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
