### Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision meets requirements

- Leaders understand the importance of gathering and collating the views of staff, parents and children to continually improve the service offered.
- Leaders and staff know how to provide an enjoyable range of physical, creative and imaginative experiences for children during the school holidays.
- Leaders understand the importance of keeping a two-way flow of information between staff and parents. Leaders and staff know to share information about children's interests, care and medical needs at the earliest opportunity to provide continuity.
- The leadership team understands its responsibility to protect children from harm. The team knows to follow robust recruitment and induction procedures to ensure staff suitability. They understand the importance of providing staff with regular training to keep their safeguarding knowledge up to date.
- Leaders and staff know how to help children to recognise and accept each other's differences. There are clear guidelines for behaviour and systems in place to celebrate children's achievements in order to promote their confidence.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

#### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector held discussions with a member of the leadership team and staff to assess their knowledge of how they will deliver a range of activities for children.
- The inspector observed areas to be used for the care of children and discussed the programme of activities, equipment and toys used for children. The inspector took account of the views of older children spoken to on the day.
- The inspector reviewed a range of documentation covering children's information, policies and procedures, daily records and risk assessments.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the leader and staff, and took into consideration the suitability checks.

Super Camps at Shrewsbury High Preparatory at Kingsland Grange was registered in 2009. The setting employs six members of childcare staff. Of these, one holds an appropriate early years qualification at level 3 and one holds level. The setting opens from Monday to Friday during school holidays. Sessions are from 8am until 6pm. At the time of the inspection there were no early years children present.
