### The provision meets requirements

- The provider understands her role in safeguarding and protecting children from harm. She understands her responsibility for child protection, the importance of the managing any concerns, including how to report these to the correct agencies.
- The provider understands how to positively manage children's behaviour, encourage children to use good manners and to show respect to each other.
- The provider discusses how resources and activities are used to excite the children and to encourage them to develop new skills and make progress.
- The provider recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and others involved in the care of the children.
- The provider maintains her paediatric first-aid qualification and ensures staff in the setting also complete relevant training. She is aware of how this helps her to respond to minor accidents.
- The provider explains how she monitors her work and the work of the staff. She seeks ways to improve her own skills the skills of the staff, and how to improve the setting.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

The breakfast club open from 7.45am to 8.45am. The after school club runs from 3.15pm to 5.45pm. The provider employs two members of staff, of whom one including herself, hold relevant childcare qualifications.
