Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider has a good knowledge of the correct procedures to follow should she have concerns regarding a child's welfare.
- The provider understands the importance of working in partnership with parents, carers and others. She understands the benefits of sharing information.
- The provider understands the importance of offering an inclusive service to children and parents. She has a varied range of resources that reflect similarities and differences in the children and others.
- The provider knows how to evaluate her service in order to strive for continuous improvement.
- The provider has a sound knowledge of how to provide children with interesting and motivating activities that complements their learning elsewhere.
- The provider understands how to promote children's well-being. She knows how to help children to build positive relationships, make choices and be independent.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

The setting opens from Monday to Friday all year round. Sessions are from 7.30am until 8.40am and 3.10pm until 6pm during term time. The setting is open from 7.30am to 6pm during school holidays.
