Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands her responsibilities to safeguard children. She knows the signs and symptoms that a child may be at risk of harm and who to report her concerns to.
- The childminder knows how to support children's learning and development by providing age-appropriate activities. She has observation and assessment systems to help her promote children's progress and plan purposeful learning experiences.
- The childminder understands how to evaluate her service to impact positively on the quality of care provided.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents. She describes how she intends to share information with them about children's progress to support their learning and development.
- The childminder has completed risk assessments of her home to minimise hazards to keep children safe. She plans to provide nutritious meals and snacks to support children's health and well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
