

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 28 June 2017 we received a notification from the provider about a significant domestic incident that had occurred outside of childminding hours.

We conducted a visit to the childminder on 4 July 2017 to discuss the incident.

As a result of the visit we established that this was an isolated incident, and that the childminder had clear risk assessments in place that set out what she would do were there to be any future incident(s).

As part of our investigation we found that the childminder had not ensured that all those adults in the household had been checked by Ofsted. We therefore issued the childminder with a notice of action to improve that required her to;

Ensure that all adults living or working on the premises have their suitability established by Ofsted. The provider must ensure that all forms are submitted in a timely manner to ensure checks are completed.

We are satisfied with the childminder's response to the action raised.

The childminder remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those

registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
