

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 26 June 2017, the provider notified us that a child was left unattended at the setting. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted particulars of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for, or is in regular contact with, children on the premises to look after children.

We conducted an unannounced visit to the setting and discussed the incident with the provider who gave us detailed information about the event and the actions they have taken.

The provider took prompt and appropriate action to comply with the requirements of registration by:

Immediately updating and implementing the induction policy and procedures for new staff so they are aware of their responsibilities and how to implement the procedures effectively to safeguard children at all times. (The Early Years Foundation Stage General Welfare requirements – Staff: child ratios)

Ensuring staffing arrangements are organised robustly and the effective deployment of staff ensures the safety and that children's needs are met (The Early Years Foundation Stage General Welfare requirements – Staff: child ratios).

We are satisfied that the provider took prompt and appropriate action to ensure they continue to meet the requirements for registration.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
