Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Most staff are qualified and all are supported well. They continue with their own development, contributing to their good knowledge of how to compliment children's learning in school.
- Arrangements for safeguarding are effective. Staff understand their responsibility to keep children safe and know what to do if they have a concern about a child's welfare.
- The manager gathers the views of staff, children and parents to help identify priorities for improvement and enhance their experiences in the club.
- Staff understand children's need for reassurance to help support their emotional well-being. They discuss how they work closely with parents and teachers in school. They regularly exchange information to help them to meet the individual needs of children.
- Staff understand how to manage children's behaviour effectively.
- Staff discuss the importance of teaching children about healthy lifestyles.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector had a tour of the premises.
- The inspector held a discussion with the manager and spoke to staff during the inspection.
- The inspector looked at relevant documentation, such as evidence of the suitability checks carried out on staff working in the club.

Middleton Tyas Before and After School Club registered in 2010. The setting employs five members of childcare staff. Of these, four hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3 or above, including one at level 6. The setting operates during term time. Sessions are from 7.30am until 8.45am and from 3.15pm until 6pm, Monday to Thursday. On Fridays, sessions are from 7.30am until 8.45am and from 3.15pm until 5.30pm.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
