## Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision does not meet requirements

- Staff do not understand the importance of supervising children and ensuring that they are within sight or hearing at all times. Staff do not consider how to keep children safe when other members of the public are using the same facilities.
- The provider does not ensure that staff receive effective coaching and support. The manager and staff do not have a sufficient understanding of their roles and responsibilities or the requirements for the early years foundation stage.
- The provider does not ensure that all documentation is available for inspection. Although there is evidence staff have Disclosure and Barring Service checks, other required documentation was not available to demonstrate how safe recruitment procedures are followed.
- Staff do not maintain an accurate record of children's attendance.
- The provider does not evaluate the setting and has failed to identify the significant breaches in requirements.
- Staff understand the importance of providing children with daily physical exercise and access to games and resources.
- Staff demonstrate a suitable understanding of child protection issues and know who to go to if they have a concern about a child in their care.
- Staff understand the importance of working in partnership with parents and they explain how they gather information to help them meet children's individual needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

# What the setting needs to do to improve further

We will issue a Welfare Requirements Notice requiring the provider to:

Haydon Centre registered in 2015. The after-school club operates during term time only. Staff collect from three local schools. Operating times are on Mondays to Thursdays from 3pm to 6.15pm and on Fridays from 1pm to 6.15pm. The holiday club operates in half-term holidays and full holidays, excluding bank holidays. There are four staff working with the children. The manager holds an appropriate qualification at level 4 and three staff hold appropriate qualifications at level 3.
