## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider understands her responsibilities to follow local safeguarding children's board procedures to safeguard children. The premises are safe and secure.
- Staff demonstrate that they understand how to plan a variety of activities that help children to enjoy their time at the club. They understand the importance of working in partnership with school staff to build on children's knowledge and skills.
- The provider reflects on the services that are provided and works closely with parents and children to find out their views. Staff explain how they share information between the club and home, in order to ensure continuity of care and learning for children.
- Staff understand the benefits of ensuring that children have daily opportunities to play outside where they can be more physically active.
- The provider understands the importance of providing ongoing discussions regarding staff's professional development to identify where further training is required.
- Staff are aware of the need to offer a positive and welcoming environment to help children feel settled and to ensure that their emotional well-being is promoted.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector held discussions with the provider and staff.
- The inspector had a tour of the premises and discussed procedures relating to health and safety.
- The inspector viewed documentation regarding recruitment and the suitability checks carried out on staff working at the setting.

Rascals 2000 registered in 1995. The club opens Monday to Friday during school term times. Sessions are from 3.30pm until 6pm. The club employs seven members of childcare staff, all of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3.
