Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to protect children and report any child protection concerns to appropriate local safeguarding agencies to support their welfare.
- The childminder recognises the importance of helping children settle and encouraging them to form strong relationships. She knows how to support children to manage their feelings and understand behavioural expectations.
- The childminder understands the importance of keeping children safe and healthy in the home and when on outings. She talks about providing children with regular opportunities to be outside and active, involving them in assessing risk.
- The childminder provides a range of age-appropriate resources. She understands how to plan exciting experiences which support children's interests and build on what they know. She understands the importance of assessing children's progress and sharing information with parents and other early years settings children attend.
- The childminder recognises the importance of evaluating her provision and considering parents' and children's views.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
