## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager and the staff understand how to protect children from harm and keep them safe. They know the importance of reporting concerns to the correct agencies.
- The manager and staff understand how to manage children's behaviour positively to encourage children to use good manners and to show respect to each other.
- The manager discusses how staff use the resources and activities to motivate the children and to encourage them to learn new skills.
- The manager understands the significance of working in partnership with parents and others involved in the care of the children.
- The manager maintains her paediatric first-aid qualification to help her to respond to minor accidents and emergencies and ensures staff in the setting complete training.
- The manager explains how she monitors the enjoyment children have and evaluates practice. She seeks ways to improve the setting to benefit children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector observed the environment for children's indoor and outdoor play.
- The inspector talked to staff and held discussions with the manager and provider.
- The inspector examined documentation, including a sample of children's and staff records.
