Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Staff work closely with parents and other providers, such as schools, to further enhance and complement children's learning so that they continue to make progress.
- Staff know how to effectively safeguard children. They understand what to do if they have concerns about children's welfare and recent training has helped them keep up to date with current legislation.
- Staff understand the importance of carrying out regular risk assessments to minimise hazards and provide a safe environment that promotes children's general well-being.
- Staff understand how to positively manage children's behaviour. They know how to help children to build relationships, encouraging them to consider the needs of others and to share and take turns.
- The manager and staff understand the value of continuous reflection of practice and the importance of feedback from parents and children. An action plan is in place showing clear direction for the club. This demonstrates capacity to improve and to further develop the provision.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had a tour of the areas used by children at the club.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager and staff about the learning and development and safeguarding and welfare requirements.
- The inspector and the manager discussed and looked at toys, books, resources and equipment that she intends to use for children in the early years age group in the indoor and outdoor areas.
- The inspector sampled relevant documentation, such as policies and procedures, including the complaints procedure. She checked that the insurance is in place at the club.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability of staff working in the club.

Hucknall Out of School Club registered in 2007. The club employs 15 members of childcare staff. Of these, six hold an early years qualification at level 3 and one at level 2. The club opens Monday to Friday during term time. Sessions are from 7am to 9am and from 3.30pm to 6pm. During the school holidays, the club operates from 7am to 6pm. The holiday sessions operate throughout all school holidays, except the Christmas period and bank holidays.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
