## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager has a good understanding of her responsibilities to safeguard children. Staff know how to identify child protection concerns and understand the appropriate reporting procedures to follow.
- The staff and the manager know how to use the key-person system to help meet children's emotional needs and to help them settle.
- There is a wide range of resources for children of all ages and the manager and staff understand how to use these to promote children's development and enjoyment.
- The manager is aware of how to promote children's awareness of healthy lifestyles, such as through healthy snacks, meals and opportunities for children to be physically active.
- The staff understand the importance of helping children to develop respect and build good relationships.
- The manager and staff build good relationships with parents, the host school and other settings the children attend, to share information about the children. They know how to promote children's independence to help them prepare for life at school.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector checked documents, including staff suitability checks and training certificates.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager about the club's self-evaluation processes.
- The inspector looked at a range of the club's policies and procedures, including those relating to safeguarding children.

ChuckleBox Out of School Club registered in 2001. The club is situated in West Wickham, in the London Borough of Bromley. The club is open after school from 3pm to 6pm during school term times. During school holidays, the club operates from 8am to 6pm. There are five staff employed to work with the children, three of whom hold relevant childcare qualifications.
