Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider and manager have a secure understanding of safeguarding procedures. This helps them to proceed appropriately if they have concerns about a child's welfare, including how to protect children from extreme views. The provider understands and implements the statutory requirements as required.
- The manager knows how to carry out visual checks and risk assessments to identify and reduce the risk of potential hazards to children. The premises are safe and secure, and there are resources suitable for the age and stage of children's development.
- The manager understands the importance of promoting children's good health, such as through daily routines, nutritious snacks and exercise.
- The provider and manager know how to further develop their childcare knowledge, for example, through attending training around supporting children with special needs. They know how to seek guidance from external agencies to help update and improve staff practice and to support children.
- The manager shows a secure understanding of how to manage children's behaviour and help them learn the club boundaries, and respect and treat others kindly.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector checked the suitability of the rooms and the outside play area that will be used for children.
- The inspector looked at a selection of the records and policies and procedures that the club intends to use when caring for children.
- The inspector discussed with the manager how she intends to evaluate her practice.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability of the manager and staff.

Busy Living After School Team @ Bearbrook registered in 2013 and is run by Busy Living Limited. It operates from Bearbrook Combined School in Aylesbury, in Buckinghamshire. The club employs eight members of staff. Of these, five hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 2 or above, including two who hold a degree in early years. The breakfast club is open from 7.40am to 9am, and the after-school club is open 3.15pm to 6pm, term time only. A holiday club opens from 8am to 6pm during school holidays.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
