## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider has met the action raised at the last inspection. Information has been provided to Ofsted of the changes to committee members. There are regular supervision meetings with staff to help enhance their professional development.
- The manager and staff team understand their responsibility to follow the Local Safeguarding Children Board procedures. The premises are kept safe and secure.
- The manager and staff team understand how to plan a variety of activities that helps children enjoy their time at the club. Children make choices about their play.
- The manager and staff team understand how to promote children's health, physical development and well-being. Children are provided with daily opportunities for outdoor play and have a range of healthy snacks. Staff help children to learn about good behaviours and to think about the needs of others.
- The manager and staff team understand the importance of working in partnership with parents to benefit children. They work closely with staff in school to further complement children's learning and build on their skills.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector held discussions with the manager and staff working in the club.
- The inspector had a tour of the premises where childcare is provided.
- The inspector looked at evidence of the suitability of staff and committee members. She also looked at a sample of policies and procedures.
- The inspector looked at staff files, including qualifications and training certificates.
- The inspector spoke to a small number of parents and took account of their views.

Springdale After School Club registered in 1997. The club opens from Monday to Friday, term time only. Sessions are from 7.30am until 8.45am and 3.15pm until 6pm. The club employs three members of childcare staff. Staff hold qualifications ranging from level 2 to level 3.
