Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good understanding of how to keep children safe. She is knowledgeable about the signs and symptoms of abuse and reporting procedures. She explains how she plans to use risk assessments to help her protect children.
- The childminder describes how she intends to gather information from parents when children first start regarding their prior skills. She explains how she plans to observe children and use assessments to identify any gaps in learning.
- The childminder speaks with passion about how she intends to evaluate her service and implement plans to help her to continually raise the quality.
- The childminder values the importance of working with parents and other professionals involved with children to help her to provide an inclusive setting and consistency.
- The childminder understands how young children learn. She describes how she plans to interact during child-initiated play and plan a range of interesting and challenging activities to help children reach their full potential.
- The childminder explains how she plans to support children's emotional well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The childminder registered in 2015 and lives in the Blackley area of Manchester. She operates all year round from 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Friday, except bank holidays and family holidays.
