Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to identify, record and report child protection concerns, if these arise.
- The childminder has completed robust written risk assessments of her home and outings. Measures are in place to minimise potential risks, supporting children's safety.
- The childminder understands the importance of evaluating her service. She explains how she intends to continue developing her skills through regular training.
- The childminder intends to plan daily trips and outings within the local community. This will enable children to be physically active, promoting good health and well-being.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnerships with parents. She intends to share information with parents regarding children's progress.
- The childminder provides a range of interesting and age-appropriate resources to stimulate children's learning. She intends to identify starting points, regularly assess children's progress and plan suitable activities to support ongoing development.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to deliver the educational programmes for children and undertake observation, assessment and planning.
- The inspector discussed the policies and procedures with the childminder and viewed documentation that she will use when caring for children.
- The inspector had a tour of areas in the premises to be used by children and discussed the equipment and toys available.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the childminder and took into consideration suitability checks for persons living on the premises.
