

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 17 October 2017 Ofsted received concerns that the provider had not informed us of a significant event which may have affected her suitability. These concerns relate to the early years foundation stage (EYFS) welfare requirements.

We undertook a telephone investigation on 18 October 2017, we considered all the information. The provider sent us documentation relating to the concerns and we reached a decision that the provide remains suitable for registration.

Our investigation showed that the provider had not informed Ofsted of a significant event. This is an offence under the Childcare Act 2006 regulations. As a result we have issued the provider with a warning letter and decided to not take any further action. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
