## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider understands child protection issues. She is aware of the procedure to follow should there be any concerns about a child's welfare. She ensures that staff receive regular safeguarding training.
- The provider has developed good links with the schools that children attend. She is knowledgeable of how to complement children's learning experiences at school.
- The provider demonstrates an understanding of the importance of sharing information with parents and other professionals involved in the children's care.
- The provider understands the importance of reflecting on and evaluating the quality of the setting. She ensures that staff attend regular training to keep their knowledge and skills up to date.
- The provider understands how to promote children's good health. She recognises the importance of providing children with a choice of healthy meals and regular opportunities to be physically active.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector viewed all areas of the premises, including the range of toys and resources, and discussed the evaluations that the provider uses to plan for improvements.
- The inspector checked evidence of staff's suitability and qualifications.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the provider.
- The inspector discussed with the provider how she intends to complement children's experiences at school.

Kids Kapers After School Club registered in 1999. The club is open Monday to Friday, during school term time. Sessions are from 3pm to 6pm. In addition, a holiday club is provided during most of the school holidays from 8am to 5pm. The club employs four members of childcare staff. Of these, two hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3 or above.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
