Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The leader and staff keep up to date with early years foundation stage requirements and changes to legislation. They attend useful courses and seek information online.
- The leader knows how to assess children's individual starting points. She is aware of how to use assessment information to plan and provide learning activities and support that help children make progress.
- The leader and assistants understand how to keep children safe and protect them from harm. The leader knows the action to take should she or the assistants ever have concerns about a child's well-being.
- The leader and assistants understand the importance of teaching healthy lifestyles to children, establishing good hygiene routines and managing children's behaviour.
- The leader and staff know how to build partnerships with parents and other settings children attend, to share information about children's learning and specific needs.
- The leader and assistants understand the importance of reviewing provision and seeking the views of parents to identify areas for improvement.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector checked the areas used by children.
- Discussions were held with the leader about her practice, how she will assess children's needs and provide suitable learning activities and support for them.
- The inspector viewed policies and held discussions with the leader about how these would be implemented.
- The inspector checked the arrangements for safeguarding children.
- The inspector checked other required documentation, such as qualifications and paediatric first-aid certificates.
