The provision meets requirements

- The childminder keeps her safeguarding knowledge up to date and has researched other safeguarding issues. She has completed mandatory training to keep her knowledge current.
- The childminder knows how to plan and provide activities to interest children. She understands the importance of a good relationship with parents, to share information to help her monitor and track children's progress.
- The childminder intends to visit parks, local places of interest and woods to help develop children's knowledge of the local community. She knows how to promote children's understanding of cultural diversity. She is aware of how to teach them to behave well, respect one another and be tolerant of others' beliefs.
- The childminder recognises the importance of evaluating her practice to plan for improvements and intends to seek the views of parents and children to ensure this.
- The childminder is aware of the skills children need to help them be more independent and prepare them for school.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
