## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager knows how to identify and minimise potential hazards. The environment is safe for children. The manager understands how to support children's good health.
- The manager has a secure understanding of his responsibility to safeguard children, including how to check staff's suitability to work with children and report concerns regarding children's welfare.
- The manager has strategies to manage children's behaviour and teach them to respect others.
- The manager recognises the importance of planning activities based on children's interests and requests to help motivate them to develop their knowledge and skills.
- The leadership and management team knows how to work in partnership with parents and the school to promote consistency in children's care and learning experiences.
- The leadership and management team has addressed the action and the recommendations raised at the last inspection. It understands the need to evaluate its service and to act upon parent's views to bring about improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector spoke to the manager about the practices and procedures, including the arrangements for safeguarding.
- The inspector went on a tour of the environment with the manager and discussed safety procedures.
- The inspector looked at samples of documentation, including staff training certificates and the public liability insurance certificate.
