- Managers and staff know how to help children show respect to others, behave well and celebrate similarities and differences to support their awareness of diversity.
- Managers understand the importance of evaluating practice and of including the views of children and parents, to help develop their setting further.
- Staff are aware of the importance of having good partnerships with parents and other settings that children attend.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke with staff and questioned them on their understanding of how to keep children safe.
- The inspector checked evidence of staff suitability, professional qualifications and paediatric first-aid certificates.
- The inspector sampled a range of policies and procedures, including safeguarding, risk assessments and public liability insurance.
- The inspector viewed areas of the school used by children.

SCL Care Club - Milford Infant School registered in 2017. It operates from Milford Infant School in Goldalming, Surrey. The breakfast club operates from 7.45am to 8.45am and the after-school club operates from 3.15pm to 6pm on weekdays, term time only. The holiday club operates Monday to Friday during most school holidays and sessions are from 8.15am until 5.45pm. Four members of staff work with the children. All staff hold relevant childcare qualifications.
