Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The manager understands how to support children's individual needs and progress. She knows how to plan, observe and assess their achievements to help them develop in all areas of learning.
- The manager recognises the importance of working together in partnership with parents and other professionals. She knows how to develop consistent links to support children's emotional and learning needs.
- The manager knows how to provide an inclusive service, ensuring there is a wide range of toys and resources. She understands how to organise activities to suit children's different needs and interests, to help prepare them for their next stages in learning.
- The manager knows how to identify signs and symptoms which may suggest potential child protection concerns. She keeps her knowledge of safeguarding up to date so she can report any concerns quickly.
- The manager understands the benefits of self-evaluation and uses this to identify areas for improvement to support children and their families further.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector had a tour of the areas of the premises used by children and staff.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager about how she organises the setting and manages staff.
