Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The manager has a robust understanding of her role in keeping children safe. She knows how to ensure that staff understand their responsibilities regarding child protection and the procedures to follow for any concerns.
- The manager explains how staff use a variety of methods to promote a consistent approach to encourage children's positive behaviour.
- The manager recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals. She discusses how to promote continuity of care and complement children's learning at school and other settings they attend.
- The manager understands how to promote children's health and physical and emotional well-being. She knows to provide children with healthy food and regular exercise.
- The manager demonstrates how she regularly seeks the views of parents and children and uses this information to drive ongoing improvements.
- The manager understands how to use what they know about children and their interests to plan and provide activities that complement children's experiences elsewhere.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the manager how she intends to complement children's early years experiences in school and about the types of activities they provide.
- The inspector discussed the policies and procedures with the manager and viewed documentation that staff will use when caring for children.
- The inspector toured the areas of the premises used by children and discussed the toys and equipment available.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the manager and took into consideration the staff suitability checks.

St Andrews Kids Club After School & Holiday Play Scheme registered in 2015. The club employs seven members of childcare staff. Of these, six hold appropriate early years qualifications to at least level 2, including four staff members who hold a qualification at level 3. The club opens from Monday to Friday during term time and also operates a holiday club. Sessions are from 7.45am to 9am and 3.15pm to 6pm. The holiday club sessions are from 7.45am to 6pm.
