- The childminder understands how to monitor children's progress from their starting points. She knows how to plan a range of interesting activities that supports children's individual learning needs.
- The childminder knows how to promote good values, such as how to behave. She understands how to help children share their thoughts and views, and appreciate other people's differences and similarities.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's good health and well-being.
