Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff understand their roles and responsibilities to safeguard children. They know the signs and symptoms that would lead them to have concerns about a child's welfare and the correct reporting procedure to follow.
- The manager and staff carry out self-evaluation to identify areas to strengthen. They regularly gather the views of parents and children. Their ideas are incorporated into the plans for future development and improvements at the club.
- The manager understands the importance of establishing effective working partnerships with the host school. She discusses how to provide activities that enhance the learning experiences that take place in school.
- The manager explains how staff use a variety of methods to promote a consistent approach to encourage children's positive behaviour. Staff understand the importance of supporting children's independence during routines and activities.
- The manager understands how to support children to develop healthy lifestyles. Staff provide healthy snacks and opportunities for children to have daily physical exercise.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises used when providing care for the children.
- The inspector discussed the manager's knowledge of the early years foundation stage requirements.
- The inspector held meetings with the manager of the club. The inspector sampled a selection of documentation, including safeguarding procedures, performance management and the club's self-evaluation record.
- The inspector checked evidence relating to the suitability of staff.

Southwell After School Club registered in 2010. The club employs four members of childcare staff. Of these, three hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3. The club opens Monday to Friday from 7.30am to 9am and from 3.25pm to 6pm during school term times.
