## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The deputy manager demonstrates an understanding of child protection procedures in line with those of the Local Safeguarding Children Board. She is aware of the signs of abuse and neglect, including the procedures to report any concerns.
- The deputy manager knows how to support children's health and well-being. The premises are safe and secure for children. All staff hold valid paediatric first-aid qualifications and an appropriate first-aid box is available and accessible.
- The deputy manager understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and professionals through effective communication. She knows that a two-way flow of information supports continuity of care and play experiences for children.
- The deputy manager knows how to provide children with a healthy and nutritious diet. She understands the importance of providing daily opportunities for children to be physically active outdoors.
- The provider has maintained public liability insurance.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector had a tour of the areas of the premises used by children and discussed the equipment and toys available.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the deputy manager.
- The inspector looked at the documentation that the club intends to use when caring for children.
- The inspector reviewed evidence of suitability checks and training for all staff working or associated with the club.

Umbrellaz Childcare registered in 2013. The setting employs two members of staff, both of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3. The setting opens Monday to Friday during term time only. Sessions are from 8am until 9am and from 3.30pm until 6pm.
