## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager is aware of the need to plan interesting and engaging experiences based on children's individual needs and interests. She demonstrates a good understanding of how to deliver the early years foundation stage.
- The manager has completed child protection training and knows what to do if concerns arise. She describes how she would address possible risks to children's safety and health, and shows a good understanding of how to help protect children's welfare.
- The manager understands the importance of working with parents, and others involved in children's care and development, to help her provide consistent care and enjoyable experiences for all children.
- The manager describes how she plans to involve parents in her observations and assessments of children. She explains how she intends to share information with parents about children's progress and work with them to close any gaps in learning.
- The manager plans to seek the views of parents and children to evaluate the service and make improvements so children are able to achieve positive outcomes.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

#### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector reviewed documents, including children's records, evidence of professional development, policies and registers.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to deliver the educational programmes for children and undertake observation, assessment and planning.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the manager and checked evidence of the suitability of staff.
- The inspector looked at the resources and areas of the after-school club that children use, inside and outdoors.
