Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder keeps her first aid and safeguarding knowledge current. She identifies the signs of abuse and neglect and knows the local referral procedures to follow if she is concerned about a child. She is aware of the signs of children being drawn into situations that may put them at risk of significant harm.
- The childminder identifies and understands how to minimise potential risks in her home. She recognises the importance of keeping required documentation and records up to date. Admission forms include detail about children's different needs.
- The childminder understands how to observe children, determine their stage of development and plan activities to promote the next steps in their learning. She provides a good variety of resources and activities.
- The childminder understands her role to work in partnership with parents. She provides information about her provision, such as through written policies and procedures.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke with the childminder throughout the inspection.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the childminder's home that are used for childminding.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she plans to meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and promote children's progress.
- The inspector looked at evidence of the childminder's training and checked evidence of the suitability of all adults in the household.
- The inspector looked at policies, procedures, and a range of documentation.
