

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 28 November 2017, the setting received an early years inspection. With a judgement of inadequate with enforcement, we served a welfare requirements notice and raised six actions around safeguarding practice and training, supervision and the key person system. We visited the provider on 10 January 2018 to check compliance with the early years foundation stage. We found: the provider had attended relevant safeguarding training; the safeguarding policy and procedures had been updated in line with the Local Safeguarding Children Board guidelines; all staff members had completed training on the Prevent duty; there was a system in place for staff supervision; staff understood the need to disclose any information that may affect their suitability; and, the provider had made all parents aware of their child's key person. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website

for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
