Fordham Care4kids C.I.C. registered in 2015. The out-of-school club employs two members of childcare staff. Of these, one holds qualified teacher status. The club opens Monday to Friday during school term times. Session times are from 7.30am to 8.40am and from 3.15pm to 6.15pm.
