- The childminder provides a wide range of toys and play materials to support children's all round learning. She intends to observe and assess children's progress and plan challenging activities to support their next steps in learning.
- The childminder undertakes robust risk assessment procedures. She has created a safe and secure environment for children to play and learn.
- The childminder understands the value of working in partnership with parents to promote continuity of care and learning for children. She intends to provide an inclusive service where all children are equal and respected.
- The childminder understands her responsibilities to safeguard children. She knows how to identify, record and report child protection concerns to promote children's welfare.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
