Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands her responsibility to safeguard children. Both she and her assistant regularly update their safeguarding and paediatric first-aid training.
- Following the last inspection, the childminder now carries out risk assessments of her premises and the garden to ensure children stay safe.
- The childminder understands the importance of providing children with a healthy diet and how to promote their independence.
- The childminder knows how to use a range of effective and consistent strategies to promote children's positive behaviour.
- The childminder is aware of the importance of working in partnership with parents to meet children's needs. She understands how to use observations and assessments to monitor children's development, to help them make good progress.
- The childminder has a wide range of toys and resources easily accessible for any children she may care for, including resources reflecting differences in people and their cultures.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The childminder registered in 2014. She lives in Walthamstow, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest. The childminder operates from Monday to Friday from 8am until 6.30pm all year round; except for bank holidays and family holidays.
