Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to provide a range of experiences for children that helps them make progress in their learning. She understands how to assess children's development and plan activities that will interest and challenge them.
- The childminder has a good understanding of safeguarding. She knows how to keep children safe in her home and whom to contact if she has concerns about the welfare of any child in her care.
- The childminder acknowledges the importance of providing an inclusive environment to help all children to feel happy and secure. She knows how to develop children's confidence and independence so they are ready for starting school.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and finding ways to involve parents in their children's learning.
- The childminder is aware of the need to evaluate her practice, develop her skills and keep her knowledge up to date.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector checked evidence of the childminder's qualifications, and suitability of the childminder and those within the household.
- The inspector looked at relevant policies and documents that the childminder uses when caring for children.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the home available for childminding and discussed with the childminder how she uses the space.
- The inspector asked the childminder to discuss how she would meet the individual needs of children.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she would deliver the educational programmes and evaluate her practice. ?
