## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider knows how to keep children safe from harm. Staff have training to help them feel confident about what to do if they have a concern about a child's welfare.
- Staff know how to provide suitable activities that cater for children's individual needs, age and interests. This includes children who have special educational needs (SEN) and/or disabilities.
- Staff recognise the importance of working with parents and other professionals to help ensure children's individual care needs are met.
- The provider understands the importance of evaluating the practice and planning how it can be improved further. Staff recognise the benefits of listening to and taking account of the views of parents and children.
- Effective recruitment procedures and suitability checks are in place to ensure staff are suitable to care for children.
- Staff know how to help children of all abilities to settle in and feel secure at the club.
- Staff appreciate the benefits of providing children with healthy snacks and appropriate exercise to help them understand about healthy lifestyles.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector discussed safeguarding requirements with the provider to check her understanding of how to keep children safe.
- The inspector checked relevant documents, including policies, procedures and paediatric first-aid certificates.
- The inspector visited all parts of the premises that are available for the club, including resources indoors and outdoors. She discussed with staff how they intend to provide appropriate activities for early years children.
- The inspector discussed with the provider how she evaluates the service.

KIDS Heathfield Extended Clubs registered in 2009. The club is open for up to 30 days a year during school holidays from 9.30am to 3.30pm. It also runs on occasional Saturdays from 9.30am to 3.30pm. The club provides care solely for children who have special educational needs (SEN) and/or disabilities. There are eight members of staff who work with children, one of whom holds a qualification at level 3. KIDS is a national charity providing services to children who have disabilities.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
