## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good understanding of safeguarding. She knows how to keep children safe in her home and whom to contact if she has concerns about the welfare of any child in her care.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and, for example, helping them to be involved in their children's learning.
- The childminder is aware of the need to evaluate her practice to help develop her skills and keep her knowledge up to date.
- The childminder has a range of suitable resources for children of all age ranges and knows how to positively manage children's behaviour.
- The childminder knows how to observe, plan and assess children's progress, to help them prepare for their next stages of development, and share this with parents.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to deliver the educational programmes and evaluate her practice.
- The inspector checked the suitability of the rooms that will be used for childminding.
- The inspector looked at a selection of the records and policies and procedures that the childminder will use when caring for children.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability of the childminder.
