Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider has a clear understanding of her safeguarding responsibilities, including the need to ensure children play in a safe environment. All staff complete the required suitability checks and are inducted in the organisation's policies and procedures.
- The manager takes responsibility for planning appropriate activities and experiences for children, taking into account their interests and differing needs.
- The provider and manager understand how to encourage children's personal, social and emotional development and promote their emotional well-being.
- The provider and manager are aware of how to work in partnership with other professionals to support children's individual needs.
- The provider and manager reflect on the quality of the provision and experiences provided for children at the end of each holiday to see what went well and what areas they could improve for next time.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector engaged in discussions with the provider and manager about the organisation of the playscheme.
- The inspector looked at and discussed some of the written policies and procedures used to support the running of the setting.
- The inspector checked how the provider is meeting the safeguarding requirements and looked at records relating to staff suitability and records of risk assessments.

The playscheme is open during some school holidays, from 10.30am to 3.30pm. There are 19 members of staff, including the manager and sessional staff. The manager holds a relevant degree in early years. The playscheme provides care for children who have special educational needs/and or disabilities.
