## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- Leaders and staff understand how to safeguard and protect children. They know the procedures to report any concerns about a child's welfare, including allegations.
- Leaders and staff know how to complete risk assessments to ensure children play in a clean and safe environment. Leaders know how to complete suitability checks to recruit staff to work with children.
- Staff recognise the importance of working with parents to share information about the club's routines and procedures, to make them aware of what to expect. They know how to obtain children's personal details to meet their needs and interests.
- Staff understand how to support children to develop their personal and social skills. They know how to set boundaries to teach children right from wrong.
- Staff know how to plan age-appropriate resources and opportunities for children to explore, to keep them engaged and to provide learning experiences at the club.
- Leaders understand how to evaluate the club and gather feedback from staff, parents and children. They know to provide training opportunities for staff.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector discussed with the leaders how they intend to provide activities and experiences that support children's learning.
- The inspector looked at the club's policies and documents it intends to use when caring for children.
- The inspector discussed with the leaders their processes for self-evaluation and the club's improvement plan.
- The inspector viewed resources and had a tour of the areas of the premises used for children of the after-school club.
