The provision meets requirements

- The childminder demonstrates that she understands her responsibilities in protecting children from harm and neglect. She has a secure understanding of the reporting procedures to follow in the event of a concern about a child in her care.
- The childminder demonstrates how she works in partnership with parents. She describes how she supports children's development by making suggestions to parents about how they can support their child's learning at home.
- The childminder describes the seven areas of learning and the assessment methods she follows in line with the learning and development requirements. She demonstrates how she plans activities to help support children's communication and language skills.
- The childminder discusses how she observes the children as they play and makes an assessment about their current stage of development. She describes how she uses this information to identify what children need to do next to progress.
- The childminder discusses how she supports children's overall health and supports parents to provide their children with nutritionally valuable foods.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
