Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to keep children in her care safe from harm. She knows how to identify, record and report child protection concerns. Premises are safe and secure.
- The childminder understands how to provide appropriate activities to meet the needs and interests of individual children. She knows how to assess and monitor children's progress.
- The childminder understands how to help children behave well and respect the opinions of others.
- The childminder understands the importance of working closely with parents and other professionals to share information and promote continuity of care and learning.
- The childminder understands the value of regularly seeking the views of parents and children to help her evaluate her setting. She recognises the importance of keeping up to date with current practice through training.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
