## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider knows how to keep children safe from harm. Staff have training to help them feel confident about what to do if they have a concern about a child's welfare.
- Effective recruitment procedures and suitability checks are in place to ensure staff are suitable to care for children.
- Staff appreciate the benefits of providing children with healthy snacks and appropriate exercise to help them understand about healthy lifestyles.
- Staff recognise the importance of working with parents and other professionals to help provide consistency for children's learning and care.
- The provider understands how to help children learn to respect one another and how to promote children's good behaviour.
- The environment is well maintained and well resourced. Children have the opportunity to access a range of resources.
- The provider evaluates the quality of the provision to continually make improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector had a tour of the areas used by the children and viewed the equipment and resources available.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability of staff working at the club.
- The inspector looked at a selection of policies and records.
- The inspector spoke to the area manager and the manager about the service provided.

THE PARTYHOUSE registered in 2013. The after-school club employs two members of childcare staff. Of these, one holds an appropriate early years qualification at level 3. The after-school club opens from Monday to Friday during term time. Sessions are from 3pm until 6pm.
