Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The management is not fully aware of its responsibilities to notify Ofsted of changes to the committee. It does not fulfil its responsibility to ensure that new committee members follow the necessary procedures, in order for Ofsted to complete the required suitability checks.
- Staff have a confident knowledge of safeguarding. They understand the signs that may indicate a child's welfare is at risk and know what to do if they have any concerns. Staff know to carry out regular checks on the environment to identify and eliminate any potential risks to children.
- The management and staff demonstrate that they follow robust recruitment procedures to ensure that staff working with children are suitable.
- Staff have a good understanding of how to meet children's individual needs. They know how to plan activities that build on the children's skills.
- Staff understand the importance of providing children with opportunities for fresh air, exercise and healthy food.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and the Childcare Register the provider must:

ensure that Ofsted is notified of all changes to the committee, and 12/04/2018 new committee members follow through their roles and responsibilities to provide Ofsted with the relevant information to enable suitability checks to be completed.

- The inspector held discussions with the manager and staff.
- The inspector checked evidence of staff suitability and qualifications.
- The inspector observed a variety of activities both inside and outside.
