The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to use observation and assessment to help plan for children's future learning. She is aware of how to monitor progress, to aid her in identifying any extra support needed for children's development.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other early years providers to support children's ongoing care and learning.
- The childminder is aware of self-evaluation and the relevance this has on monitoring her practice to make targeted improvements.
- The childminder has processes in place to monitor her assistant to ensure the quality of teaching reaches a good level.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
