

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 12 July 2017 we carried out an inspection that judged the requirements of the Childcare Register were not being met. Following the inspection we issued the provider with notices to improve that required them to:-

ensure at least one person caring for children has an appropriate first aid qualification, including outside the setting when taking and collecting children between the setting and school.

make sure sufficient staff is present to care for the children at all times. At least one person must be the provider, manager or person who works for the provider to care for the children.

ensure that any person caring for and in regular contact with the children is suitable to work with children. This must include obtaining an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service Check.

take all necessary measures to minimise any risks to children's safety.

On 10 August 2017 we carried out an unannounced visit to the setting. We interviewed the provider, scrutinised documentation and viewed areas available for children. We found that the provider has ensured that at least one member of staff holds an appropriate first aid qualification; that sufficient staff are present to care for children and that necessary measures were in place to minimise any safety risks. However, it was found that the provider had not ensured that all staff have obtained a Disclosure and Barring Service Check.

A further notice to improve was raised in regards to

ensure that any person caring for and in regular contact with the children is

suitable to work with children. This must include obtaining an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service Check.

This notice to improve will be monitored further.
The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
