Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Staff have a clear understanding of how to protect children from harm. Procedures are in place to help staff to report concerns and to work with other agencies.
- Staff demonstrate that they play an integral part in continuously improving the service. Ongoing training, evaluation and forums help to identify possible improvements.
- Staff demonstrate an awareness of supporting children's healthy lifestyles through exercise, healthy food and hygiene procedures, to support their physical well-being.
- Staff have a positive attitude towards providing stimulating activities. They know how to support children's learning using information from parents, schools and other settings.
- Staff know how to encourage children to share their views and value other's backgrounds. They act as positive role models to support children's emotional well-being.
- Staff demonstrate a clear knowledge of how to work in partnerships with parents. Procedures are in place to provide families with feedback about what children have participated in and friendships they make, such as via a website and display board.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

It operates Monday to Friday from 8am until 6pm during Easter and summer school holidays. The setting employs three members of staff, one of whom holds an early years qualification at level 3.
