Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to safeguard children and the procedures to follow to protect children from risk of harm. She knows how to risk assess her premises and take action to keep children safe.
- The childminder is aware of how to manage children's behaviour, help them to understand their feelings, and value each other's differences.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other providers children attend, to work together consistently to support children's learning and development.
- The childminder knows how to plan her environment and activities to help children make progress and prepare them for school. She understands her responsibilities to monitor children's development and ensure they receive additional support where needed.
- The childminder understands the importance of evaluating her practice and seeking parents' feedback to continue to make improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she will monitor children's progress and plan activities to meet the needs of different ages of children.
- The inspector looked at how the childminder plans her environment to meet children's care and learning needs.
- The inspector checked safeguarding information, the safety of the premises and the childminder's knowledge of child protection procedures.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she will manage children's behaviour and provide an inclusive environment.
- The inspector sampled documentation the childminder has ready to start minding again.
