

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 2 and 13 March 2018, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We found the provider has breached requirements by not notifying Ofsted of significant events.

We have served a notice to improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below by 18 May 2018.

- implement a policy and procedures to safeguard children in line with the guidance and procedures of the relevant Local Safeguarding Children Board
- ensure the designated safeguarding lead/leaders and staff attends training that helps to enable identify, understand and respond appropriately to concerns
- notify agencies with statutory responsibilities without delay when there are concerns about children's safety and welfare
- improve supervision of senior leaders/managers and staff to ensure they understand their roles and in particular safeguarding responsibilities.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider responded satisfactorily. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
